BEST MEAT, SAUCE AND SIDE CONTEST RULES

1. Teams must file an Entry Form with \$150 payment or confirmation of locating a Team Sponsor (\$350) to Madelyn Perry (perry@hapsonline.org) with Houston Area Parkinson Society to reserve a spot by March 27, 2019. Spaces are limited and will be approved on a first-come-first-serve basis.
2. The cook-off site will open at 5 AM for registration and set up. Prep ahead of registration is permitted. The cook-off begins at 6 AM. Each team will begin serving their meat, sauce and side to judges at 10:45 AM – don't be late! VIP guest arrival begins at 11 AM, and general entry is at 12 PM.
3. Teams will be assigned a 10' x 10' preparation area. If you need more room, let us know.
4. All teams must consist of at least two people.
5. Each team will donate 300 servings of meat, sauce and sides to the Blues Brews and BBQ Cook-off for consumption and sale that day. Food trays and utensils will be provided by Blues Brews and Barbecue Cook-off.
6. Each team is responsible for all cooking utensils, chairs, cooking ingredients, set up and clean up. A tent or overhead covering of some sort is required.
7. Each team must supply all cooking equipment: propane camp stove, grills, generators, etc. (No electrical outlets are available, but water will be).
8. All ingredients must come from approved food sources, so it's absolutely safe for public consumption. For questions, contact the Harris County Health Department.
9. Each contestant will be assigned a contestant number by the chief scorekeeper and given a 1 lb. food tray. An official of the cook-off will deliver the bite entries to the judges for a blind taste test.
10. Judges will announce the Blues, Brews and Barbecue Cook-off winners around 1:00 PM. The winning teams will be presented with a plaque and will earn bragging rights. The decision of the judges is final.
12. The public will select the People's Choice Award. The public will have the opportunity to vote digitally. The team with the most votes overall wins. It's up to you to entice them to try your best work and cast their vote for you. The more food you have, the more votes you can get – but a minimum of 300 servings. People's Choice Award winner will also receive a plaque. This will be announced towards the end of the event (5 PM).
